

Karapiro Development update

Mighty River Domain

Council has signed a 10-year sponsorship agreement with Mighty River Power, the land adjacent to the lake will now be known as Mighty River Domain. Signage reflecting the name change will be installed over the next few months.

Events and Community Centre

Precast wall panels are now up, and steel work is arriving on site and being erected for the mezzanine floor areas.

A temporary events headquarters has been set up onsite to run the summer series of events from Mighty River Domain. This is located behind the Don Rowlands tower and will be removed March 2010.

Grandstand and St John's room

Design plans are being completed for the grandstand and new St Johns facility which will replace the existing terraces in front of the new Events and Community Centre.

Walkway

Over the next two months a lakeside concrete walkway will be constructed from the new Event centre north to the pontoon area.

Foreshore retaining walls

Some sections of the foreshore retaining walls have been identified as needing repair work. This work has been progressing while lake levels have been relatively low and before major events are scheduled.

Maintenance shed

A building permit has been lodged for the relocation of the maintenance shed from the centre of Mighty River Domain to the end of Judd Lane. This work is programmed for the next month.
