## About Us...

Lake Karapiro Camping and Pursuit Centre is situated in a public domain on the banks of Lake Karapiro. It is 10mins drive from the beautiful town of Cambridge and 30mins drive from Hamilton City. It is a peaceful area with stunning scenery and vast amounts of open space for any activities. We offer a wide range of activities on and off the water that will suit all groups such as school camps, corporate groups and families.

### **Instructors:**

We currently have a large pool of qualified and experienced instructors and facilitators to meet the needs of your outdoor pursuits based program.

Our staff come from a variety of backgrounds including such places as Auckland University of Technology – Diploma in Outdoor Recreation Leadership, WINTEC – Sport and Recreation Courses.

They hold a variety of qualifications from NZQA Units, through to industry recognised certificates and New Zealand Outdoor Instructors Association and Mountain Safety Council Awards, and all undergo a site specific familiarisation annually.

Our staff under go a vetting process, which includes Police Vetting through the Police Vetting Services in Wellington, using the New Zealand Criminal Database and reference checks.

Once your program details are confirmed we can send you down the exact qualification etc of the facilitator that will be looking after you.

## **Accommodation:**

### **Rob Waddell Lodge**

As well as outdoor activities we have accommodation. Our Rob Waddell Lodge sleeps up to 41 people in a bunk style format. It also has a large kitchen and dining area that is large enough to cater for all groups. It also has a laundry with a large washer and dryer.

### **Chalets**

Our five **chalets** sleep 8 people in each and have a shower and toilet in each. There are two kitchens and a laundry situated in the chalets next door. Both our lodge and chalets have all the cooking utensils, cutlery and plates needed by the groups.

### **Bunkrooms**

Our **bunkroom** is for the groups with a lower budget. There is one room with 14 bunk beds. These rooms also have toilets and showers that are situated next door. The kitchen facilities for the bunkrooms are not as equipped as the lodge and chalets and **groups must bring their own cutlery and crockery.**

### **Camping Ground**

We are also a camping ground; we provide both powered and non-powered sites. Our camping ground also has a toilet, laundry and kitchen block but groups need to bring their own cutlery and crockery for this facility.

\*The lodge, chalets and bunkrooms all have a minimum charge per night; please see pricing page for details.

## **Other Services:**

### **Catering**

Lake Karapiro Camping and Pursuits Centre has worked with caterers from Cambridge for many events, if your group wishes to have a caterer to make life a bit easier we can organise this for you.

### **Cleaning Services**

We ask that the facility are left in the same state as when you went into them, if you do not wish to clean the accommodation it can be organised through the office that our cleaners do it for you for a set price.

### **Programme Design**

All groups have different goals and expectations; this is why we try to create a programme that will suit the individual group. If there are specific goals that you want the group to achieve please discuss this with the office and they will work with the instructors to create a programme that works for you.

### **Need a quote?**

For a quote, please ask the office and they will create one for you.

### **Rubbish**

We will collect all of the rubbish for you, if you put all rubbish into the bins that are situated outside of your accommodation the rubbish will be collected when necessary.

## **What to bring...**

- Sleeping bag, blanket and pillow
- Warm clothing
- Towels
- Toiletries
- Drink bottle
- Sturdy footwear
- Plenty of changes of clothes (especially if you are doing water activities)
- Sunscreen
- Hat
- Raincoat
- Sports gear

If groups are staying in the bunkrooms or the camping ground they will also need to bring all of their cooking equipment and crockery.

## Conditions of Hire...

### PARK RULES

- Arrival:** Arrival Time: 1.00 pm (accommodation will only be held until 4.00pm on day booked unless a full nights deposit has been received)
- Departure:** Departure Time: 10.00 am
- Accounts:** Balance of accounts are payable on arrival.  
Payment must be made for the full time booked.
- Tents:** Electricity can only be connected through an approved isolating transformer or RCD Safety Switch
- Caravans:** Including campervans must have current electrical warrant of fitness and comply with LPG Standard (NZS 5248: 1996)  
Provide own waste container. Empty chemical toilets and wastewater in dump station only
- Parking:** Vehicles to be parked on own site only - not on driveways or neighbour's site.
- Speed:** Speed in camping ground is walking pace only.
- Conduct:** Quietness between 10.30pm and 7.00am  
No loud swearing or bad language. Reasonable behaviour and dress at all times. Breaching of the rules will result in, you being required to leave the Park without refund.  
No liquor to be consumed in park except on your site or in your unit.  
*Consideration must be shown at all times to other guests.*
- Damage:** Cost of damage to property or accommodation will be recovered. This includes the discharge of fire extinguishes without need
- Children:** Children must be under parental supervision at all times including while using the facilities.
- Visitors:** By courtesy of the management at all times.  
Remember you are responsible for your visitors.  
Visitors depart by 10.00pm. Visitor's vehicles are to be left in the visitor's car parks at all times.
- Pets:** Not admitted. NO DOGS! (\$300.00 fine)
- Rubbish:** To be wrapped or put in bags and placed in receptacles provided.
