

# Waipa District Refuse and Recyclables Collection Guidelines

The Waipa District Refuse Collection and Disposal Bylaw was enacted on 1 August 2007. A key provision of the Bylaw is the licensing of recycling and refuse collectors and facility operators. The following Guidelines should be read in conjunction with the standard Terms and Conditions of Licence for Waste Collectors and Waste Management Facility Operators.

## Days and Areas

Refuse and Recyclables collection days and areas are identified in the Council's collection maps or are in accordance with a Waste Collector's Licence.

## Approved Receptacles

Plastic bag	60L	Gross weight of bag and contents shall not exceed 15kg	Household Refuse
MGB	120L	Gross weight of bin and contents shall not exceed 30kg	Household Refuse, Recyclables, Green Waste
MGB	240L	Gross weight of bin and contents shall not exceed 95kg	Household Refuse, Recyclables, Green Waste, Paper Waste
Recyclables Crate	55L	20kgs	Recyclables
Cardboard box of a similar capacity to a Recyclables Crate (domestic collection of Recyclables only).		Must be a capacity and strength to enable collector to lift safely and easily	Recyclables Paper Waste
