



**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO
REVIEW CAMBRIDGE TOWN BELT
MANAGEMENT PLAN
UNDER SECTION 41 OF THE
RESERVE ACT 1977**

The Waipa District Council gives notice of its intention to review the Cambridge Town Belt Management Plan (1996).

The Cambridge Town Belt is an encircling band surrounding the township of Cambridge. It is approximately 304ha and comprises both Recreation Reserve and Local Purpose Reserve.

It is described as: Allotments 1 to 4, 6A, 7, 7A, 8 to 14, 17A, 18, 18A, 19 to 44, 47, 48, 50, 53, 56 to 67, 69 to 89, 91 to 94, and part allotments 5, 6, 15 to 17, 45, 46, 49, 51, 52, 54, 68 and 90, Cambridge Town Belt; Allotment 370, and part Allotments 365, 366, 368, Town of Cambridge East, Allotments 424 and 425, Town of Cambridge West, Lot 1 DP 25378, Lot 1 DPS 10007, and Lots 1 and 2 DPS 1357; all situated in Blocks IX and XIII Cambridge Survey District. Vogel Street, Sections 1- 3, SO 58417 are Local Purpose Reserve (originally part Allotment 8), McLean Street, Part Section 38 is also Local Purpose Reserve.

The Cambridge Town Belt as contained within the balance of the 1984 New Zealand Gazette Notice is classified as a Recreation Reserve pursuant to Section 16 of the Reserves Act 1977 and vested in the Waipa District Council in trust for that purposes by virtue of Section 16A. The Local Purposes Reserves are similarly held by Council in Trust.
