Medium Density Residential Standards

My submission is

I support the intent of the plan change and believe it should proceed. We are currently in a housing crisis, with home ownership become more of a distant dream for more and more people. This plan change will allow more more houses to be built which will increase supply, keeping to suppress price increases, or maybe even help bring houses down.

The current plan does not sufficiently allow for the types of housing which we need moving forward. People no longer need a 1/4 acre, and are more than happy living in a cheaper townhouse. The explosion of townhouses in the last 5 years reinforces this. Allowing townhouses will allow for more affordable housing options to be available to people in Waipa more broadly.

Increasing housing density will also help stop productive farmland being taken over.

I acknowledge three stories and three homes is a lot, so maybe we should manage this to 2 storeys and 2 residential units per title.

I seek the following decision/s from Council

To proceed with the intent of the proposed plan change and allow more housing intensification.
