



NOTIFICATION OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES

In accordance with the Tenth Schedule of the Local Government Act 1974, notice is hereby given that, for the purpose of the Targa Rotorua-Hawkes Bay 2019, Waipa District Council intends to consider closing the roads listed below to ordinary vehicular traffic for the periods stated hereunder.

Please note some roads listed below are controlled by other local authorities and are included to showcase the full routes taken.

Friday 17 May 2019

Waterworks from 10.10am - 2.10pm

Waterworks Road from 300 metres from the intersection with Chepmell Road to Te Miro Road

Te Miro Road from Waterworks Road intersection past Gray Road, Maungakawa Road, Harbutt Road and Flume Road

Aspin Road to property 77 Aspin Road

Maungatautari from 11.50am - 3.50pm

Maungatautari Road from 300 metres from the intersection with Hicks Road past Taane Road to Head Road intersection

Head Road from Maungatautari Road intersection to finish at Stokes Road intersection

Stokes Road from Head Road intersection to finish at Maungatautari Road intersection

Maungatautari Road from Stokes Road intersection to Oreipunga Road

Oreipunga Road from Maungatautari Road intersection past Roberts Road, Plantation Road, Finlay Road, Makgill Road and Westlea Road to 300 metres from the intersection with Arapuni Road

Mangare Road from 12.20pm - 4.20pm

Mangare Road from 200 metres from the intersection with Rotongata Road, past Landing Road to the intersection with Pukewhau Road

Pukewhau Road from Mangare Road to 350 metres from the intersection with Waipapa Road

Aotearoa Road from 12.45pm - 4.45pm

Kahorekau Road 200 metres from the intersection with Waipapa Road to the intersection with Aotearoa Road

Aotearoa Road from the intersection with Kahorekau Road to 170 metres from its intersection with Waipapa Road to property 168 Aotearoa Road

To assist with the stage security, the closure is also to include up to 100 metres of each adjoining road, from where it intersects within this road closure.

Vehicles may be able to gain access to these roads during certain times of the closure, provided safety is not compromised. Approval must be given by the Targa Base Manager.

During the proposed closure arrangements will be made for the passage of emergency vehicles if required.

Any person objecting to the proposal is called upon to lodge notice of his/her objection and the grounds thereof, in writing, before **4.00pm on Tuesday 19 March 2019**.
