

Public Notice of Application for On Licence

Section 101 Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Vilagrad Wines Limited, private company of Ohaupo, has made application to the District Licensing Committee at Waipa District Council for the renewal of, and to vary licensed area (i.e. a variation of condition (5) increasing the outdoor licensed area and reducing the indoor licensed area) of, an on-licence in respect of the premises situated at 702 Rukuhia Road, Hamilton, and known as Vilagrad Wines.
