# ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- The nominee must have resided or attended school for at least six months in the Waipa District for the period 1 Feb 2015 - 31 Jan 2016.
- Nominees must be between 14 and 18 years of age from 1 Feb 2015 - 31 Jan 2016 (inclusive).
- Achievement(s) must have been attained during the period 1 Feb 2015 - 31 Jan 2016 (inclusive).  
A detailed written application of the nominee's achievements and successes is required for this period, and must be submitted on the official nomination form. Nomination forms are available from Council offices, district libraries and the Council's website - [www.waipadc.govt.nz](http://www.waipadc.govt.nz).
- Nominees can only be nominated for **one** of the five individual categories, **plus** the multi-achiever category if there are strong credentials for nomination in **more than one** of the individual categories.
- For sport nominations only** - please provide contact details for a key person in the nominee's sport. This may be necessary for the judges to obtain clarification as there are multiple categories and classes within some sports.
- A photograph of the nominee participating in their field of achievement is required for the event programme and presentation purposes. Please attach a current photograph to this nomination form or email the digital file to [cathy.plowright@waipadc.govt.nz](mailto:cathy.plowright@waipadc.govt.nz). If you don't have a photograph of the nominee performing in their field, another profile picture will be accepted. If a photograph is not received by the nomination closing date, a school ID photo will be requested.** (Council reserves the right to use photos to promote the Awards.)
- Please ensure that both nominee and nominator have signed this form.
- Nominations must be posted or delivered to the Te Awamutu or Cambridge offices of the Waipa District Council, or submitted on-line at [www.waipadc.govt.nz/youthawards](http://www.waipadc.govt.nz/youthawards), by 5pm, Friday, 1 April 2016.
- There will be one 'Excellence' winner and as many 'Merit' and 'Achiever' awards for each category as the respective judges determine are deserving.
- A formal Awards Ceremony will be held on Thursday, 16 June 2016 at Te Awamutu College, Te Awamutu.
