In accordance with the Tenth Schedule of the Local Government Act 1974, notice is hereby given that, for the purpose of the Te Awamutu Christmas Parade, Waipa District Council intends to consider closing the roads listed below to ordinary vehicular traffic for the periods stated hereunder.

Saturday 8 December 2018

From 7.00am to 4.00pm

Mahoe Street from Arawata Street intersection to Selwyn Lane intersection.

From 7.00am to 4.00pm

Alexandra Street from the Mutu street/Rewi Street intersection to Sloane Street/Alexandra Street intersection.

Churchill Street from Mahoe Street intersection to Mutu Street/Mangapiko Street intersection.

Selwyn Lane and Gorst Avenue from Mahoe Street intersection to Arawata Street Intersection

From 11.00am to 4.00pm

Mahoe Street from the intersection with Churchill Street to Arawata Street.

Arawata Street from Mahoe Street intersection to the Sloane Street/Alexandra Street intersection.

Please note traffic management will be set up prior to the start time, cones and signs will be on the road ways.

During the proposed closure arrangements will be made for the passage of emergency vehicles if required.

Any person objecting to the proposal is called upon to lodge notice of their objection and the grounds thereof, in writing, before **4.00pm on Thursday 18 October 2018**.
