



## NOTIFICATION OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER A TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

**Lamb Street**, between Scott Street and Carlyle Street, Cambridge

**Friday 25th January 2019 12pm to 2:30pm**

**Bank Street**, between Roche Street and Valie Street, Te Awamutu

**Saturday 26th January 2019 7am to 5pm**

**Maungakawa Road** between Fencourt Road and Te Miro Road, Te Miro

**Sunday 27th January 2019 9am to 5pm**

**Queen Street** between Bryce Street and Victoria Street including Dick Street from Alpha Street

**Sunday 27th January 2019 12pm to 2pm**

**Queen Street** between Hamilton Road and Bryce street including Vogel place, access for the above closure will be restricted as riders finish (wait of 5min max)

Emergency services will be notified that access to this sections of roads will be limited during the road closure.

Please note traffic management will be set up prior to the start time, cones and signs will be on the road ways.

Any person objecting to the proposal is called upon to lodge notice of his/her objection and the grounds thereof, in writing, before **4pm, Friday 16 November, 2018**.
