- 1. The Hearings Panel has read the submission lodged by the group of persons listed in their collective submission as the 'Hautapu Landowners Group' (Submitter number 21).
- 2. The Hearings Panel has identified an issue of scope in part of the submission lodged by the Hautapu Landowners Group. The issue of scope relates to the Hautapu Landowners Group's request to rezone land owned by individual members of the Group from Rural to Deferred Industrial.

 - (b) Proceed to have the issue of scope considered and decided by the Hearings Panel, either on the papers or in a pre-hearing forum, before submitter expert evidence is filed on PC17 in accordance with the timetable set out in the Hearings Panel's Minute #1.
 - If a pre-hearing is the preferred option of the Hautapu Landowners Group, the prehearing will be convened on a date to be advised in February and will be open to all submitters and further submitters to participate.
- 4. The Hearings Panel will issue a further Minute if required following receipt of the response to its direction in paragraph [3] of this Minute.
