

I endorse Deans points especially the lack of consultation with HLG on the Kama Trust Resource Consent, particularly their moving of the wastewater pump station without consultation, but mostly I am amazed about the complete lack of consultation on their toxic arsenic dump site right next to our vegetable garden, chickens and our water bore.

This lack of consultation has been occurring since we first heard of the rezoning when Beca the Council and Kama tried to railroad us out of the way and into submission and has been their one consistent approach since

My written statement outlines the key issues, so what I would like to say to you today is this

What is different about us, the HLG? Well we are the people paying all these experts and we are the people living on the land

We are the only ones living on the properties adjacent to this development, we are the only ones who are what I call Collateral Damage.

We were just the ones who bought in the Wrong place at the Wrong time. We don't want to be here,

Everyone else here aspires to be here, the lawyers and the planner and the experts all trained to be here, we are NOT developers we didn't buy in this location to make money, we bought for lifestyle reasons.

We are not the initiators or architects of this rezoning

I want you to know what Collateral Damage feels like

It feels like being a pawn in a bigger game you have no control over

It feels like we have no control over our own lives anymore

It feels like we are locked into a slow and exhausting and expensive process

We are stuck in a run-down house not worth investing in

We live next to noisy diggers and trucks all day and likely for the next 5 years

Being Collateral Damage is stressful, it is draining, disempowering, uncertain, not knowing if or when we can move on with our lives

We are tired, we have lost family dreams, horse riding dreams and achievements – all sold and gone. We have forgone many holidays we had planned where the money has been spent on experts. Experts who are all going on overseas holidays while we go to work to pay for it all. We get to stay home and listen to the diggers.

We have Not tried to stop Kama Trust or the Council, we only sort a pragmatic outcome to be able to move on with our lives

Yet here we are seen as the enemy trying to change the rules

We just want an outcome which allows us to get on with our lives Now NOT in 5 years

I could whine on about lack of consultation

Why wasn't the Kama Trust land rezoning made public in our LIM report?

Why isn't there dust mitigation on our boundary

How can they just move a wastewater pump station which was in the scheme plan without consultation which is going to cost us over \$1.5m???

I could go on about the serious toxic wastewater breach flooding across our property from the toxic arsenic waste dump in the Kama Trust development site which has NO stormwater mitigation designed into it. I could go on and on about the unfairness of all this, the lack of concern, the poor site planning

But to be honest I don't want to go on and on about all these things

So for me this is NOT about Transport, Water management or Economic arguments or Trigger dates. This is about people ! Us

What is a fair, safe and timely outcome? One that is Not driven by commercial self interest?

We just want to move on!
