- 4) The procedure at the Hearing will be as follows:
 - a. The Council's s42A Reporting Officer (RO) presents a brief outline and status of the proposals, including any changes since the applications were made.
 - b. The applicants present their cases.
 - c. The submitters-in-support present their evidence.
 - d. The submitters-in-opposition (in whole or part) present their evidence.
 - e. The RO responds to the above submissions and evidence.
 - f. The applicants have a Right-of-Reply.
 - g. The hearing is closed or adjourned.

- 5) **Appropriate informality** will be observed, but no cross-examination is permitted (RMA s39). However appropriate questions of witnesses may be posed through and with consent of the Commissioner.
- The submissions and evidence provided in advance will have been read by the Commissioner before the hearing. It will be appropriate for witnesses to summarise, and where desirable highlight the main points of their evidence, particularly where it challenges the s42A Report or other pre-circulated submissions and evidence.
