Thank you for your request to suspend processing of your application, which we received on 16 October 2020. This means we will not work on your application any further until the suspension period ends and the Hearing has been postponed.

The Resource Management Act 1991 allows applicants to suspend consent processing for up to 130 working days, less any time applications have already been on hold. According to our records, your application has not been on hold for any period.

You can request that the suspension ceases at any time, at which point we will re-commence our work on the application. This request must be made in writing. However, if you have not requested that the suspension ceases after 130 working days, Section 91C of the Resource Management Act 1991 requires that we either:

- return the application to you, or
- continue to process the application.

Returning the application means a decision will not be made to either grant or refuse consent. It also means that to advance your proposal you will need to lodge a new application with us, which we must consider as new.
