

TANKERED SEPTIC WASTE DISPOSAL CAMBRIDGE WWTP

Waipa District Council accepts the discharge of tankered septic waste at the Cambridge Waste Water Treatment Plant disposal facility, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- Contractors **must** be currently registered as Code Compliant under the Liquid and Hazardous Waste Code of Practice; and
- Contractors **must** hold a current Offensive Trade Licence issued by Waipa District Council, if any premises located within the Waipa District is utilised as a truck depot, waste storage facility or waste treatment facility (Website <http://www.waipadc.govt.nz/our-services/environment-and-health/Publichealth/> Application for health registration); and
- Contractors **must** hold a current Trade Waste Consent issued by Shared Services (form can be downloaded from Waipa DC website <http://www.waipadc.govt.nz/our-services/Tradewaste/Documents/Trade%20Waste%20Application%20form%20June%202014.pdf>); and
- Contractors **must** be using the WasteTRACK system to track all liquid wastes transported <http://www.wastetrack.co.nz/guide-to-wastetrack.aspx>; and
- WasteTRACK tracking form numbers must be provided for each load, **prior** to discharge; and
- Septic tank waste must be **sourced from within the Waipa District boundaries** only; and
- Only waste from **domestic** septic tanks can be discharged; and
- 24 hours notice must be given for the disposal of any wastes other than those sourced from **domestic** septic tanks; and
- To prevent cross-contamination between tanker loads when transporting wastes other than those sourced from domestic septic tanks, the tanker shall be thoroughly washed **prior** to collecting a septic tanker load for disposal; and
- The Cambridge WWTP disposal facility is **NOT** to be used as a truck wash; and
- The wash pad and solids trap must be hosed down following disposal and free from blockages.
- A sample of the waste stream discharged from a tanker load may be taken at any time upon request of the Waipa District Council at the sampling point provided. Random testing of these samples may be undertaken at any time to determine the character of the waste, and to calculate Trade Waste charges.
- A sample of the waste stream discharged from a tanker load must be supplied once a month.
- Each vehicle must use the unique key pad number issued for that vehicle.

Failure to comply with these terms and conditions will result in the suspension or cancellation of your right to discharge septic tank waste at the Cambridge WWTP.

The attached form must be completed for Access Codes to be issued.
