Te Awamutu Community Board wishes to support Council in their attempt to minimise the impact of Plan Change 26. This mandate from Central government to intensify housing and build up to 3 homes 3 stories high on a single property is not supported by our community of Te Awamutu or Kihikihi. Our community believes due to the blanket approach of the Amendment Act 2021 that it will lower property values, impact neighbouring properties eg block sunlight and have an adverse impact on our core infrastructure, parks and reserves.
