Introduction

1.

This memorandum of counsel for Waipā District Council (Council) is lodged

in response to Direction #17 of the Independent Hearing Panel (Panel) in

relation to Plan Change 26 to the Operative Waipā District Plan (PC26).

2. Direction #17 records the release and anticipated gazettal of the National

Policy Statement for Indigenous Biodiversity 2023 (NPS-IB). As the Panel has

not yet released its recommendations on the Waikato IPIs, the Panel will

need to take the NPS-IB into account in formulating its recommendations.

3. Paragraph 5 of Direction #17 proposes that, in respect of PC26, if parties

consider further evidence or submissions are required to address the NPS-

IB, it may be that this could be accommodated within the time set aside for

the remaining financial contributions portion of the hearing in September.

Proposed approach

4. The Council agrees that it is appropriate for the NPS-IB to be addressed at

the reconvened hearing in September 2023, and considers that any further

evidence and submissions from the parties can be accommodated within the

existing timetable for the reconvened hearing (recently confirmed in

Direction #16). In particular, the Council will address the NPS-IB in its section

42A report to be lodged with the Hearing Co-ordinator by 28 July 2023.
