New Zealand has a water efficiency labelling scheme (WELS) to help you choose products that use less water and save you money in the long run. It's simple - the more stars on the WELS label, the more water efficient the product is.

The WELS label displays two key pieces of information:

- a star rating indicating relative water efficiency
- a water consumption or water flow figure in:
 - litres per minute (for showers and taps)
 - litres per wash (for washing machines and dishwashers)
- litres per flush (for toilets and urinals).
